Dedication of the Poor Cemetery

Know all Men by these Presents: That the Poor Cemetery Association, a corporation duly organized and operating under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon, hereby dedicates to the public use a true plat of the property owned and laid out by the said Poor Cemetery Association, as the Poor Cemetery, and comprising all of the land in the following cities and tracts, to-wit: Beginning at the quarter section corner between Sections 21 and 22 T. 8. S. R. 40 E., of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, thence S 0° 30' E 14.00 chs. along the section line between Sections 21 and 22, thence N 89° 30' E 6.00 chs. thence N 0° 30' W 14.00 chs. thence S 89° 30' W 6.00 chs. to the place of beginning all in Union County, Oregon. The said tract of land is laid out as shown in the plat and contains 336 lots in all, the full lots are 25 feet square, the fractional lots correspond in size, as shown on the plat, with drive ways or roads as shown on the plat, there are five foot alleys as shown on the plat which are dedicated to the public except where graves are now located in such alleys; the North West corner of fractional lot No. 15 is 22 feet East and 12 feet South of the quarter section corner between sections 21 and 22 T. 8. S. R. 40 E. W. M. This agreement and foregoing plat and description of the plans of the Poor Cemetery, which is recorded at the instance of the officers of the Poor Cemetery Association, said corporation for convenience in making deeds to lots as on said plat appear, adopt the same as correct and further for the convenient use of the said grounds, for the purpose of a burying ground for the dead, the drive ways and alleys are set apart for the use of the public, purchasing grounds in the tract of land designated in said plat, and for the use of the visitors to the said grounds subject to all reasonable rules that the association may from time to time adopt, and restraining the use of the same at all times and under all circumstances, which right is hereby expressly reserved, any ground now occupied by an alley or part of an alley, said alley or part of alley so occupied shall be deemed a part of the adjacent lot, and be not dedicated to the general public.
