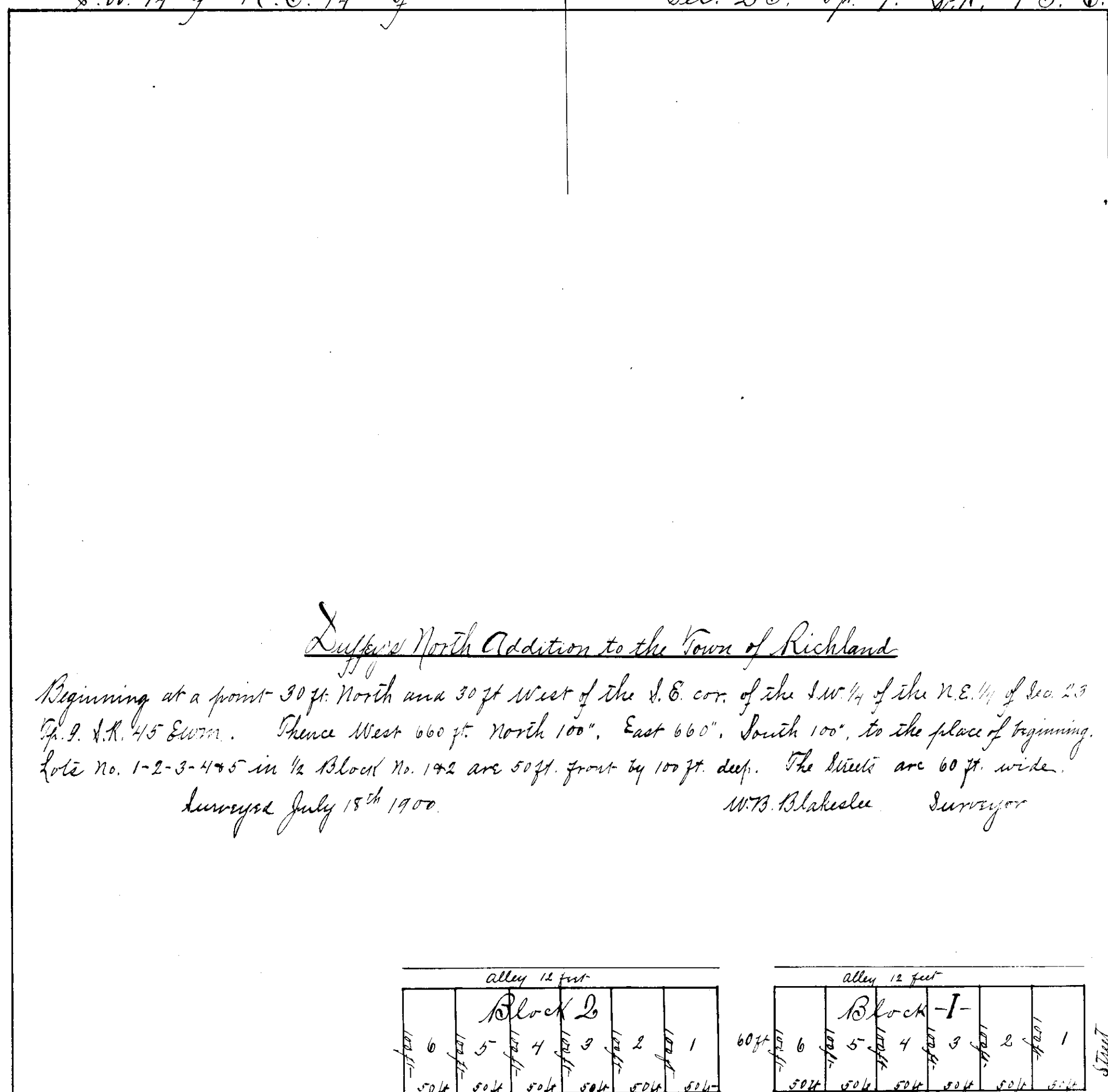


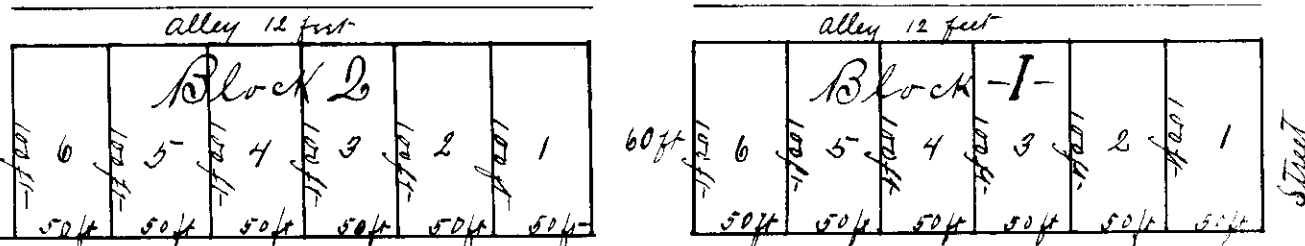

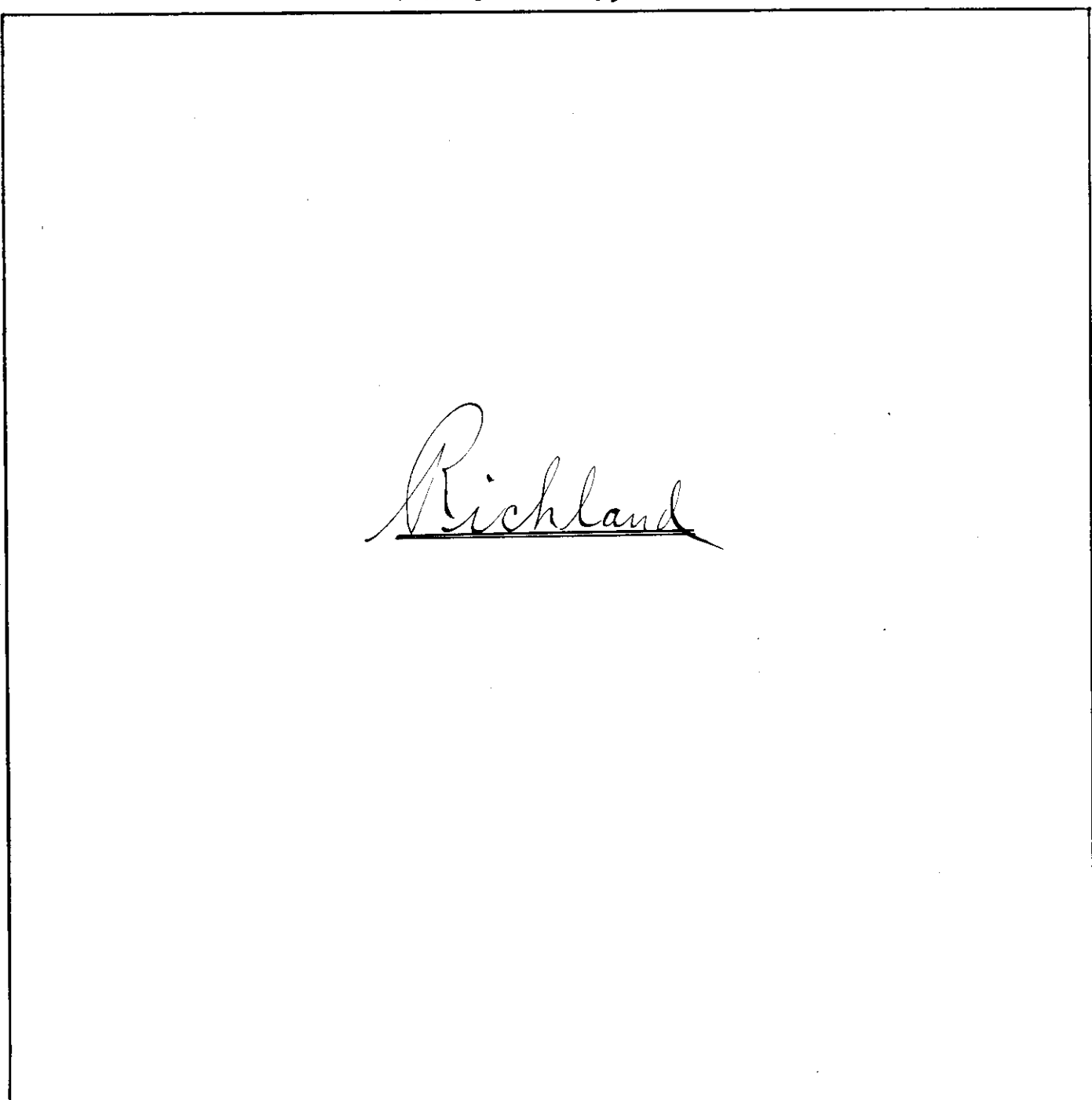


Duffey's North Addition to the Town of Richland
