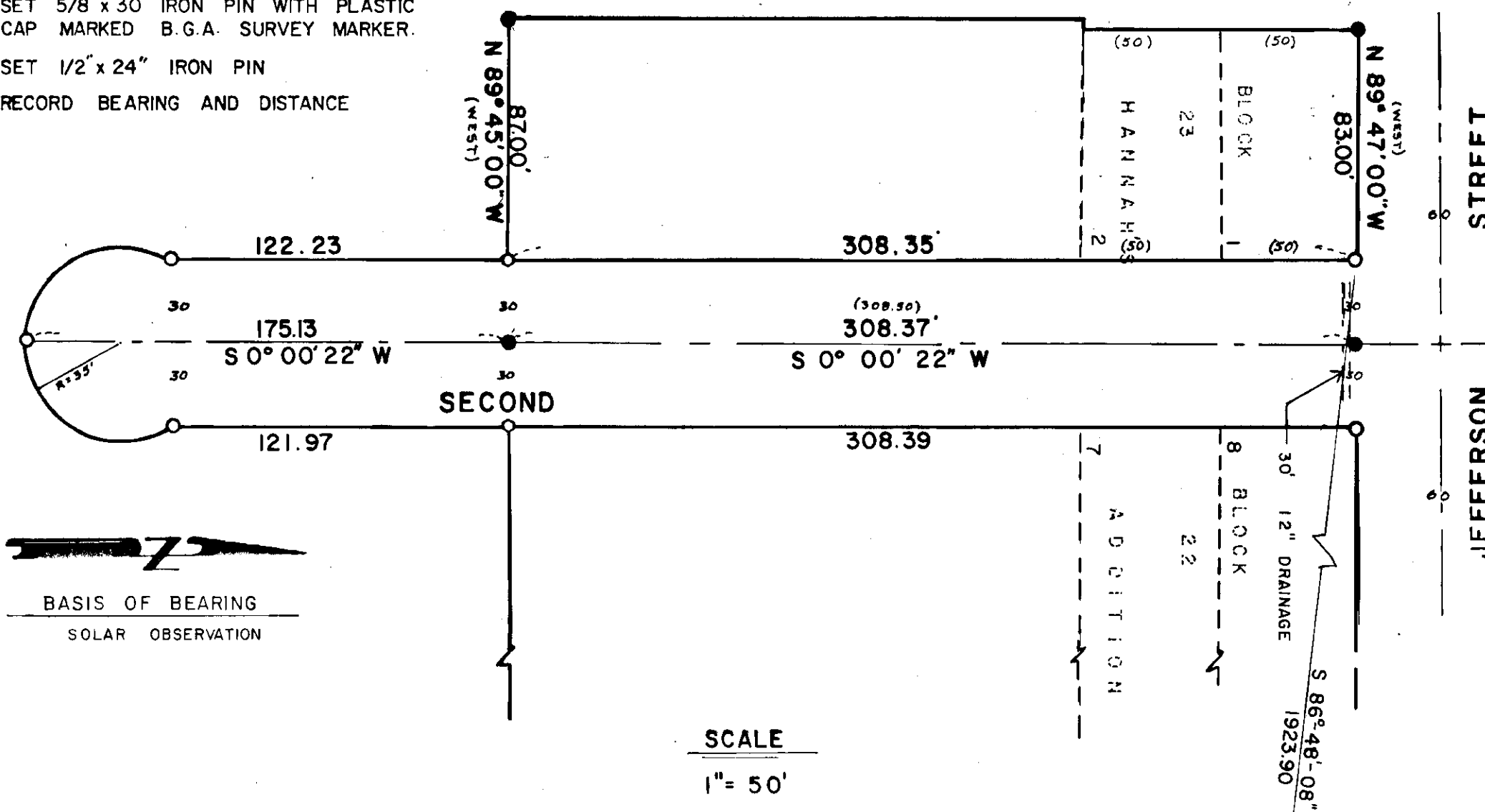

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Duane I. Griffith, surveyor, being duly sworn depose and say that I have surveyed and platted Second Street Extension, situated in the SW 1/4 of Section 19, T4S, R40E, WM, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the N.E. corner of lot 1, Block 23 of Hannah's Addition to the City of Union, Union County, Oregon, said point being 107.32 feet North and 1920.90 feet West of the center of Section 19, T4S, R40E, WM, said point also being the true point of beginning of this description; thence S 0° 00' 22" W, a distance of 430.58 feet to the intersection of a cul-de-sac with a radius of 35 feet, thence around said cul-de-sac a distance of 147.83 feet, thence N 0° 00' 22" E, a distance of 430.36 feet to the South R/W line of Jefferson Street, thence N 89° 47' 00" W, a distance of 60.00 feet to the true point of beginning; that I made such a survey and plat by order of and under the direction of the owners thereof; that all corners are marked with iron pins as shown on the annexed plat in accordance with O.R.S. 92-050, 92-060, and that the width of the street is as shown on the annexed plat.
